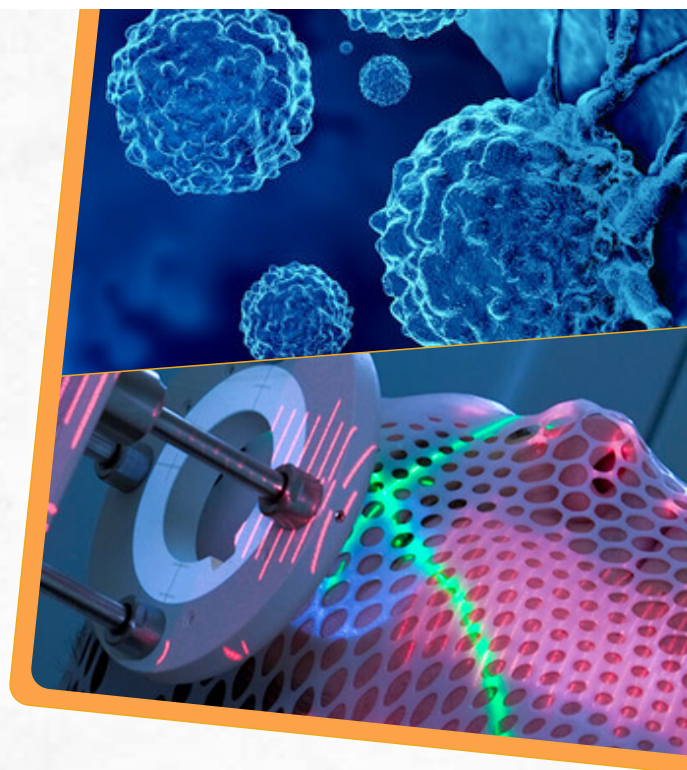

BACKGROUND & NEED

Lung cancer remains one of the leading causes of cancer-related deaths in India, with a significant proportion of cases linked to preventable risk factors such as:

- Tobacco use
- Occupational exposures
- Air pollution

Despite advancements in treatment, late diagnosis and low awareness continue to limit patient outcomes. The real opportunity lies in prevention, early awareness, and public engagement.

THE IDEA: ONCOLOGY PARLIAMENT

Oncology Parliament 2026 is envisioned as a debate-driven platform where:

- Experts debate critical issues in lung cancer management
- Youth engage through structured *OncoAssemblies* across institutions
- Public awareness is amplified through discussion, dialogue, and dissemination

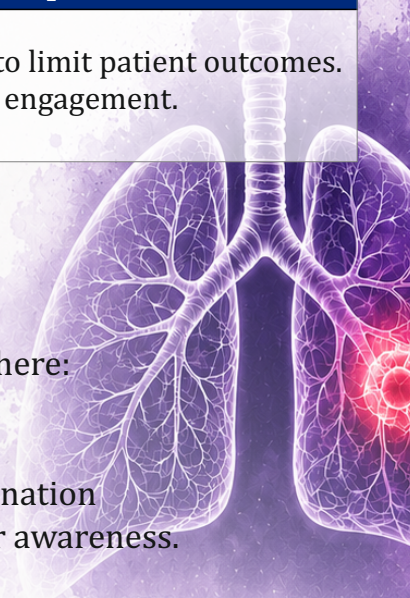
